As a Sussex County F.A. affiliated club, Lancing Rangers requires the highest standard of behaviour at all times from its officials, playing members, non playing members including parents and guardians, spectators and anyone else wishing to associate themselves with the club. To help achieve that standard, Lancing Rangers Football Club (L.R.F.C) has identified a number of club Codes of Conduct, which all officials, playing members and spectators are obliged to formally agree to adhere to.

Disregard of these Codes of Conduct may lead to discipline, suspension or expulsion from membership of Lancing Rangers Football Club.
